25.10 A) APPEAL OF SH. RAKESH MISHRA, DY. REGISTRAR AND SH. SUDEEP SINGH, ESTATE OFFICER

The appeal of Sh. Rakesh Mishra and Sh. Sudeep Singh referred from the Governor office, Punjab on the basis of the decision of the Hon'ble High Court, Chandigarh was deliberated and the reply thereof on the basis of the facts was decided to be sent to the His Excellency, the Governor, Punjab. It was resolved that since the CAG has raised the Audit Para in the year 2011 and the decision to impose the penalty was taken considering all the facts in totality and the matter has already deliberated upon multiple times with due diligence as the appeal is without any merit, so the same is required to be dismissed.

B) JUDGMENT IN THE LPA NO. 28 OF 2016 FILED BY SH. RAKESH KUMAR GOYAL AND LPA NO. 1816 OF 2015 BY THE INSTITUTE IN THE HIGH COURT OF PUNJAB AND HARYANA AT CHANDIGARH.
