PAYMENT OF TA/DA IN RESPECT OF MR. MANOJ KUMAR GUPTA, SCHOLAR, **DEPARTMENT** PHYSICS, RESEARCH **OF** LONGOWAL OUT OF THE CONTINGENCY GRANT BY GOVERNMENT OF INDIA, MHRD, NEW DELHI @ 30,000=00 PER ANNUM PER **STUDENT**

Mr. Manoj Kumar Gupta, Full Time Research Scholar with Institute fellowship, Department of Physics, SLIET, Longowal applied for approval to attend the Short Term Course to be held at Mumbai from 07.12.2009 to 15.12.2009 alongwith financial approval of Rs. 12,000/- including Course Fee, Accommodation and Travel Fee etc., which was approved by the Director, SLIET on the recommendations of Dean (PG). Accordingly the then Dean (PG) issued an Office Order No. Dean (PG)/618-621 dated 03.11.2009, allowing the Research Scholar to attend the Short Term Course and it was also added in the Office Order that he will be paid Course Fee and TA/DA. After attending the course, the Research Scholar submitted his claim bill for reimbursement out of Contingency Grant, which was returned by the Accounts Section in view of the decision taken by the Finance Committee in its 31st Meeting held on 23.02.2010. Therefore, the case was again taken up with the Director, SLIET, with the submission that the Research Scholar attended the Short Term Course at Mumbai with permission and the decision by the Finance Committee (reproduced below) was taken after two months from the date of end of Short Term Course:-

"It has been decided to follow the MHRD guidelines strictly for utilization of contingency grant by the Institute for research development and providing research facilities in terms of recurring expenditure in labs by Academic Departments".

On following points raised by Dean (Academics), worthy Chairman, Finance Committee/BOM has ordered to place the matter in forthcoming Finance Committee Meeting (Copy enclosed at Annexure - "O" Page No. 61) :-

As per version of Dean (Academics, the Central Research Committee (CRC) of the Institute in its meetings held on 4th November, 2009 and 19th November, 2009 has recommended that the Rules and Regulations of UGC/CSIR for the utilization of Contingent grant by the scholars should As per these norms, the scholars are entitled for TA/DA, be followed. Registration Fee of Course/Conference/ Symposia/workshop

Stationery Items, Photocopies, Recurring Items Chemical etc., or any other item duly recommended by the Supervisor and Head of Department of the Department and approved by the Competent Authority.

The said recommendations of CRC were taken up in the 4th Senate meeting held on 23rd November, 2009 and the Senate has approved the same. The minutes of 4th Senate meeting were further approved in the Board of Management meeting.

As per MHRD Notification No. F. 9-2/2007 TS.I dated 22nd July, 2008 (Copy enclosed at Annexure - "P" Page No. 62 - 64), the contingency grant of Rs. 30,000/- per annum per student for full time Ph.D Scholars would be given to the Institute but not to the individual concerned. Each Institute would decide the quantum of lump-sum funds to be available to each department for research after taking into account Department facilities already available. No separate salary grant would be available for research programme.

As per MHRD Notification No. F. 25-2/2010 TS.II dated 30th September, 2010 (Copy enclosed at Annexure - "Q" Page No. 65-67), the Junior Research Fellows (JRFs), Senior Research Fellows (SRFs) and Research Associates will not be entitled to DA and CCA Allowances. However, the entitlement for JRF/SR for participation scientific events/workshops in India will continue to be as earlier i.e. 2nd AC by Rail.

Keeping in view of the above, the following is submitted for needful consideration of members of Finance Committee and order please:

- 01. Decision of Senate of the Institute has already been deliberated in 31st Finance Committee meeting held on 23.02.10 in the light of Government of India, MHRD Guidelines dated 22.07.08 and passed an order that MHRD guidelines be strictly followed in terms of Recurring Expenditure in Labs by Academic Departments, mentioned above;
- 02. Government of India, MHRD Notification dated 30.09.10, as mentioned above is silent about the contingency grant to the students. So far as 'Travel Grant' for JR/SRF is concerned, it is not payable out of contingency grant, while it is paid out of General Grant-in-Aid for Travelling separately.
- 03. Travelling Claim of Mr. Manoj Kumar Gupta, Research Scholar, Department of Physics, SLIET Longowal was viewed and declined on the basis of the decision of 31st Finance Committee meeting (23.02.10) which was ratified by Board of Management of the Institute subsequently.
