With reference to IOL # SLIET/Admn./16/4620-23, dated 05.12.2016, in compliance of BOM decision, the committee was requested to provide the Recruitment Rules(RRs) on cadre restructuring report in a finalized form. The committee headed by Dr. A.S. Arora, Professor/Dean(SFW) has finalized the RRs on cadre restructuring, which are attached at Annexure-"J" (from Page No. 88 to 140). The Internal Committee recommended that Page No.7, 14 to 63 and 75 of the draft Recruitment Rules alredy prepared by the two member committee, may be replaced with the pages duly revised by the internal committee.
