

ITEM No. 54.01	<p>PERMISSION TO IMPLEMENT THE DECISIONS OF THE HON'BLE HIGH COURT OF PUNJAB AND HARYANA IN CWP NO. 10815 OF 2016, TITLED AS "NAVNEET GOYAL AND OTHERS VERSUS SANT LONGOWAL INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY, LONGOWAL, DISTRICT SANGRUR (PUNJAB)" & 11 SIMILAR CASES OF THE CONTRACTUAL EMPLOYEES OF SLIET, LONGOWAL.</p> <p>The Registrar briefed the case in detail to the BoM and also apprised the opinion of legal counsel that says "it is mandatory for the Institute to comply with the orders of the Hon'ble High Court given in the case of Ritu Mohan (CoCP 2140-2024) on 11.12.2024.</p> <p>BoM was apprised that as per Legal counsel opinion that in case the payment is not released by 08.01.2025, in that case the salary of officials of the Institute and accounts of the Institute can be attached by the Hon'ble court and even harsh orders can also be passed.</p> <p>It was also apprised that if Institute complies with the orders of the Hon'ble High Court in the case of Ritu Mohan then Hon'ble High Court may give the same decision in other similar cases which may cost of Rs. 8.00 crores (approximately) to the Institute for making payment of arrears to all other contractual staff already working and few other who left the Institute.</p> <p>BoM was also apprised that as per the orders of Hon'ble High Court Rs. 50000/- needs to be paid to Ritu Mohan by the Registrar, SLIET from his own pocket for no mistake of his.</p> <p>It was also informed to the BoM that Hon'ble Supreme Court has also dismissed the SLPs (Civil) in these cases in July-August, 2024.</p> <p>Further, the Director, SLIET intimated the BoM that the output of contract faculty and employees are not at par with that of regular employees hence, paying salary at par is not</p>

	<p>justified. The financial condition of SLIET is not very good as the fee charged from the students is very minimal compared to IITs, NITs and technical Institutions. The primary aim of the Institute is to serve the students from rural background hence the fee is kept at very lower level hence the Internal Revenue Generated (IRG) is less, due to which paying a huge sum as arrears to the litigants will impact teaching and research activities in the Institute.</p> <p>Director, SLIET also apprised that it will be better to hire additional legal counsel to defend these cases which may cost one-two lacs per hearing.</p>

The Registrar also informed about the new CoCP No. 5030-2024 that Sh. Amarjit Singh has filed against Dr. K. Radha Krishnan and another on 10.12.2024. The next date of hearing is 27.01.2025.

The Director also apprised the BoM that Institute has withheld the salary of the Registrar for the month of November, 2024 as per the orders of Hon'ble High Court dated 09.08.2024.

The Registrar also informed that Hon'ble Court has given additional three week's time to comply with the Hon'ble High Court orders which is already over on 19.11.2024 but compliance has not been done by the Institute as Institute has filed SLP in Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

BoM was also apprised that Hon'ble High Court may pass harsh decision against the Institute for non-compliance of its orders.

03.10.2024	The Hon'ble Court has dismissed the LPA -2422-2024 filed by the institute on 03.10.2024.
06.10.2024	06.10.2024, the competent authority has decided to place the matter before BoM.
13.10.2024	The BoM meeting was held on 13.10.2024 and discussed the matter in details and finally directed the Institute to file an SLP in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. Various options were also discussed regarding engagement of advocates to handle the case in the Hon'ble Supreme Court. The Board authorized the Director, SLIET to engage a suitable Lawyer in this matter and engage Additional Solicitor General Ms. Aishwarya Bhati as per requirement.
21.10.2024	The Institute has engaged Advocate Sh. Arkaj Kumar to File SLP in this case before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
28.10.2024	Institute has file CM-17854-CWP-2024 to extend the time to comply the order passed by this Hon'ble Court on 09.08.2024 in this case.
29.10.2024	The Hon'ble Court has heard the CM filed by the institute and grant three weeks time to comply with the order with some conditions.
25.11.2024	Institute has filed SLP (C) Diary no. 54854/2024 which is still pending for hearing.
12.12.2024	Amarjit Singh has filed COCP-5030-2024 against Dr. Radha Krishnan, Chairman BoM and Pro. Mani Kant Paswan, Director, SLIET which was heard by Hon'ble Court on 12.12.2024 and the next date of hearing is fixed on 27.01.2025.
18.12.2024	The matter was placed before the BoM in its 54 th meeting.
